Dear parents,

The children have settled happily back into school after the Christmas holidays and are enjoying getting started on their new topics. The Seashells are comparing the Caribbean with the UK in their 'Pirates Ahoy!' topic, the Sea Turtles are learning about woodlands and jungles, whilst the Seahorses are focussing on the Galapagos, learning about evolution and inheritance. You should by now have received a copy of your child's knowledge organiser, explaining what they will be learning about in class and also activities that you can carry out to support them at home.

Outdoor Learning

Thanks to the kindness of a local resident, we have been able to secure a new location for our Outdoor Learning, meaning that the children will be able to explore the outdoors and enjoy learning about the natural environment. When it is your child's turn to go to outdoor learning, please make sure that they have **warm outdoor clothing and wellies**, as the grass is likely to be wet and the track is quite muddy.

Environment day

Our School Ambassadors (children who have been chosen to represent their year groups), are busy planning an Environment Day, which will take place on 10^{th} February. During the day, all classes will take part in activities designed to raise their awareness of environmental issues, as well as aiming to raise some money to donate to charity. We are suggesting that children come to school dressed in 'natural' colours such as green, brown or blue, or alternatively come dressed up as something related to nature or the environment, bringing a donation of £1.

Reading books

This will make it easier for them to be responsible for their own things as they get older.
